- Functional Screenings: Evaluate and conduct appropriate functional screenings.
- Exercise Rehabilitation: Design and implement exercise rehabilitation programs tailored to individual needs.
- **Pediatric Therapy:** Provide neurodevelopmental, cognitive, and sensorimotor evaluation and therapy for children.
- Cognitive Retraining: Facilitate cognitive retraining and compensatory strategies
- **Sensory Integration:** Implement sensory integration therapy to address sensory processing issues.
- **Assistive Technology:** Assess and train patients in the use of assistive technology and daily living equipment.
- Neurological Rehabilitation: Offer rehabilitation services for neurological conditions.
- **Splinting:** Design and apply static and dynamic splints as needed.
- Motor Development: Support fine motor development and chronic pain management.
